Most people these days know the word leadership. Leadership is a part of personality\*, but is leadership a natural gift\*? Some people may be natural leaders, but most people learn to be leaders gradually\*, over many years of experience and training.

One important leader from the 20th century was Mahatma Gandhi. He was born in India in 1869. At that time, India was part of the British Empire\*, the largest and most powerful empire in the world. Gandhi thought the lives of the common people were too difficult. He worked hard to make their lives better. Many people listened to him and he became a popular person in India. He wanted independence\* for India. After many years of trying, in 1947 India became a free country. Gandhi used his leadership skills to change the world.

Some leaders change the world, but leadership happens all around us every day. Think about your school. There are many leaders in a school. Your teachers lead your classes. They choose the information to teach, and show you the best ways to learn it. They have studied long and hard to learn to be good teachers and good leaders.

Confidence\*, planning, and communication are necessary skills for good leaders. They are best learned through practice and experience. At school, participating in\* student government is an excellent way to get leadership experience. Club activities and sports teams can also be leadership opportunities\*. However, you don't need to be a captain or a president to be a leader. Participating in school activities and working with others is a great way to learn leadership skills.

Community\* activities can also be a rich source\* of leadership experience. Many great leaders began by volunteering, planning, and participating in community events. Some community leaders, like Barack Obama, become important world leaders. Others continue to work in the community to make a better life for the people around them.

In the future, people will need good leaders to solve problems like global warming, pollution, and endangered\* nature. These leaders will need to work together to create action plans. They will have to communicate their goals clearly and work together to make the world a better place for everyone. Will you be one of those leaders?
