Many people are talking about *hybrid and electric cars these days. Electric cars are not as convenient as hybrid cars, and they are more expensive. Hybrid cars can travel *farther than electric cars, but they need gasoline. Electric cars do not use any gasoline at all, so many people think they are kinder to the planet. Nowadays there are many new companies making electric cars, but the history of electric cars is actually very long.

The first electric cars were made in Europe about 140 years ago. Engineers and inventors were interested in using the new technology of electricity to make city streets quieter and city air cleaner. Electric cars were sold to rich people who wanted smooth and comfortable *transportation, and to companies that needed to move their products quickly and safely. At the beginning of the 20th century, there were more electric cars in the United States than gasoline cars.

Electric cars were popular because oil to make gasoline was expensive and difficult to find. However, before World War I, oil was discovered in many places around the world. Gasoline quickly became cheap and easy to buy, and gasoline cars became faster, quieter, and less expensive. Soon, most companies stopped making electric cars. For many years, people forgot all about them.

In the 1990s, scientists started to understand that our environment was changing. They discovered that the planet was getting warmer. One reason was pollution from all the cars and trucks burning gasoline. To solve this problem, engineers began to think about clean and quiet electric cars again.

Electric cars can help the environment by reducing the amount of carbon dioxide (CO₂) in the air, but there are some problems with these cars. Electric cars need large and heavy batteries which are expensive to make and need to be *replaced sometimes. We must make a good plan to reuse or recycle these batteries. If we don't, they will become a problem for the planet too.

The first electric cars were designed as an easier and cleaner way to move about in cities. Modern electric cars are doing the same job, but now they are much faster and go farther. Driving electric cars can help in the fight against climate change, but they are not a perfect solution. The tool we use to solve one problem should not create other problems.
